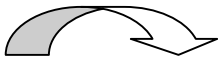

I just wanted to write a note to thank you all for making our very first meeting such a success. With 21 adult members and 11 youth, we brought in \$595.00 for operating expenses. We are off to a good start and want to keep the momentum going. Please be sure to join us June 24th at the Cottonwood Horse Park and bring others who would want to be a part of what is happening.

A big Thank You to those of you who donated the \$310.00 that came in toward the purchase of the land. Every donation helps us get closer to reaching our goal.

Legitimate concerns about insurance were brought up at the meeting, as we were going to require that everyone verify they had medical and personal liability insurance to become members. It became obvious this wasn't going to work out well, as many of you did not have insurance. After checking into it the Board of Directors feel confident that the Alaska Statute helps the Association. The signed Member Application and Waiver form will be satisfactory for all to become members. We appreciate your patience while these details were worked through. We hope you will spread the word to those who didn't join because of the insurance situation.

We are continuing in our efforts to apply for and receive grants, and are grateful to Mitch Michau and Shirley Schollenberg of the Kenai Peninsula Resource Conservation and Development District Inc for their help and expertise. They have helped in submitting our first grant application to the Homer Foundation.

It is exciting to see the progress that has been made. I appreciate the work of the entire Board of Directors as they have put in a lot of time, effort, and money to work on this project. Because of their efforts a lot has been accomplished.
