Remember to bring a framed picture of your horse, llama, alpaca, dog, cat, cow, goat or whatever to share. (There will be a table available for you to display your picture).

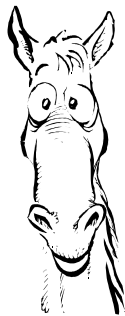
